### **Creating multiple mysql databases with single user**

The following are the instructions required for assigning multiple databases to a single user.

Before you start the steps below, you must have your databases created within Plesk. Once you have finished creating the databases you want to assign to one username, please do the following:

Please note that [Cmd] indicates the follow is the command that needs to be entered into the SSH session.

1. log into SSH for your VPS
2. [Cmd] mysql -u admin -p
3. default password: setup
4. [Cmd] use mysql;
5. [Cmd] INSERT INTO db

```
VALUES('localhost','name_of_second_db','same_username_used_for_first_db','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','N','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y');
```

Example: INSERT INTO db

```
VALUES('localhost','admin_db2','dbuser','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','N','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y','Y');
```

6. [Cmd] use psa;

7. [Cmd] select \* from data\_bases;

Take note of the 'id' of your second MySQL database.

8. [Cmd] select \* from db\_users;

Take note of the 'account\_id' of your username for the first db.

9. INSERT INTO db\_users

```
VALUES('same_username_used_for_first_db',same_account_id_for_first_user,db_id);
```

```
Example: INSERT INTO db_users VALUES('dbuser',5,3);
```

```
10. [Cmd] exit
```

```
11. [Cmd] service mysqld restart
```

```
Finished.
```
