How to Setup Customized Web Extension?

Sometimes certain web applications will require your server to create a customized web extension. This is not a problem as it is easy to create and support customized web extensions using your In2net VPS (Linux) container. For example, the application requires your server to support a "php5" extension and execute files (filename.php5) like normal PHP files. This can be achieved by creating an .htaccess file with the following line:

```
AddType application/x-httpd-php .php5
```

Once you have completed the .htaccess file, then all you need to do is upload the file to the domain's web root (i.e. httpdocs or public_html) which requires this customized web extension and that is it.

Here is a list of common application types that can be used:

```
PHP application/x-httpd-phpCGI application/x-httpd-cgi
```
